

Handicapped Bus Aide

Qualifications

1. High School graduate.
2. Interest in working with handicapped students.
3. Physically capable of appropriately lifting and managing handicapped students when necessary.
4. Ability to cope with stressful situations as related to handicapped pupils.
5. Possess or upgrade skills through formal and/or in-service training dealing with transportation of the handicapped.
6. Hold and keep current first aid and CPR certification.

Responsibilities

1. Serves as surrogate parent, friend, counselor, nurse to those on the bus.
2. Assists students entering and exiting bus.
3. Rises bus each morning to pick up students at home and take them to school.
4. Rides bus each afternoon to pick up students and return them to their homes.

Time Requirements

1. Number of days per year and hours per day as needed per route.

Evaluation

1. Yearly by director of transportation with input from driver of handicapped bus.
