

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD

QUALIFICATIONS

1. High school graduate or G.E.D.
2. Good health and physically capable of performing assigned tasks.
3. Ability to get along with children, teachers and supervisory personnel.
4. Dependable

RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Assist students in crossing streets at designated locations.
2. Stop traffic or ascertain no traffic is coming before assisting students in crossing the streets.
3. Assist, when asked, in training school safety patrol members to perform their tasks.
4. Assure safety of students through enforcement of traffic and bike safety regulations at assigned intersections.
5. Receive training and updates from local law enforcement agencies to assure proper completion of duties.
6. Report to the principal all traffic violations that effect the safety of students.
7. Report continuing student behavior problems to the building principal.
8. Other duties as assigned by the building principal.

TIME REQUIREMENTS

1. Works 180 days, 6 paid holidays, 1 or 1 1/2 hours daily depending on specific assignment.

EVALUATION

1. Yearly by building principal.
