- Asking questions, listening, and participating in class

**Shelby City Schools parents** are responsible for supporting the learning of their child by:

- Reading and discussing progress reports
- Participating in conferences
- Establishing a time for homework and ensuring that homework is completed
- Seeing that their child has a healthy breakfast and arrives at school well-rested and on time
- Supporting the school in its efforts to maintain proper behavior
- Praising the child for his/her progress and setting goals for improvement
