Engagement

- Student conversations and questions are on topic and related to the lesson's goals and content.
- Students show an understanding of what they are doing and why they are doing it.
- Students are on-task and actively participating.
- Students have the opportunity to lead learning with the teacher as a facilitator.
- Students have a variety of materials and choices to engage them.

Critical Thinking & Problem Solving

- Students discuss possible answers and think about content with varying levels of complexity.
- Students complete projects that encourage them to solve problems in creative and innovative ways.
- Students can justify their opinions or solutions with credible information.
- Students seek to understand others' perspectives, respect differences in opinions, and find ways to compromise.

Collaboration

- Students are able to work with each other independently, in pairs, or in small groups to understand or apply content.
- Students demonstrate respect for other students and adults.
- Students can identify the qualities of a valuable team member and ways they can contribute to their team.

Assessment & Feedback

- Students complete assignments and assessments based on individual needs.
- Students have options in how they show what they know.
- Students give feedback on their understanding.
- Students engage in self-reflection to understand how they learn best.
- Students and teachers provide and accept constructive feedback.
- Students create and track academic and behavioral goals.
- Students analyze each other's work.
